

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE GEARY COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
April 4, 2019

Commissioners Present: Keith Ascher, Ben Bennett, and Charles Stimatze

Others Present: Rebecca Nordyke, County Clerk and Steve Opat County Counselor

Corey Trumpp, Public Works Administrator, arrived at the meeting.

Chairman Stimatze called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mark Edwards, Attorney for USD 475, arrived at the meeting.

Mr. Opat presented the Road Maintenance Agreement between the County and USD 475 associated with the use of county-maintained roads and culverts in and around the construction site for the new high school buildings and grounds. He noted it has had extensive review by him, Mr. Trumpp and Mr. Edwards. It was approved by the USD 475 Board of Education yesterday.

Chairman Stimatze inquired if the required road inspection has been done. Mr. Trumpp stated he has been informed verbally that it was done last night, but he does not have anything in writing yet.

Commissioner Ascher moved to approve the Road Maintenance Agreement between the County and USD 475 associated with the use of county-maintained roads and culverts in and around the construction site for the new high school buildings and grounds. Commissioner Bennett seconded and all voted aye.

Mr. Edwards left the meeting.


Mr. Trumpp stated he will meet with the contractor to go over what is and is not allowed.
